

Investment Objective

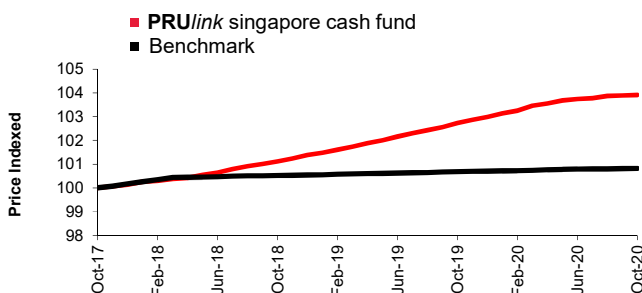
The **PRUlink singapore cash fund** aims to preserve principal value and maintain a high degree of liquidity while seeking to provide returns which are higher than those offered by Singapore dollar short term bank deposits, by investing primarily in high quality short-term money market instruments and debt securities. Such investments include Singapore fixed income deposits, short-term government and corporate bonds, commercial bills and deposits with financial institutions and similar assets.
